HAIRSTYLES

- Boys are not allowed to have fancy hair-cuts. Haircuts should be neat and simple. We also encourage senior boys to bring their own shaving sticks to use when necessary.

BEDDING

We are encouraging all parents to buy navy blue bed covers for uniformity in our hostels.

As we are approaching winter season, may you ensure that students bring warm linen and clothing. For those who may need to frequently change their bed sheets, kindly organise extra sheets.

MEDICAL FUND

Parents should bring in valid medical aid cards plus \$50 for medical purposes.

The fund may need topping if it gets used up.

Surrender all medication, medical aid cards and \$50 to the matron when signing in your child.

POCKET MONEY

- All pocket money should be surrendered to the matron when pupils are signed in. Any loss of money kept in the hostel will not be replaced by the school.
- We have noted with concern that new pupils keep their money in the hostels, we strongly discourage this.

Preferably give them loose notes for easy withdrawal.

VANDALISM OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

- We discourage vandalism of property, any student responsible will be held accountable.
- As parents, we need to continue educating our children on duty of care of property, as property can be passed on from generation to generation.
