EXCITING NEWS ON CAMBRIDGE EXAMINATION RESULTS FOR 2020

In the midst of the gloomy circumstances that we currently face in the country, we happily received our very pleasing results for the 2020 Cambridge Examinations. The results of all the levels; Checkpoint (Form 2), IGCSE / O level and 'A' level were impressive.

(a) Form Two Checkpoint

97% of our students passed the Cambridge Checkpoint Examinations. The following students had excellent average scores out of the maximum grade of six.

(c) ADVANCED LEVEL
