# CAMBRIDGE ASSESSMENT INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION EXAMINATION RESULTS 2017

'A' Level and IGCSE ('O' Level) results were released on Wednesday, 10 and Wednesday, 17 January respectively. We are all impressed by the significant improvements in performance by our pupils at both levels.

Our IGCSE/ 'O' level pass rate improved from 72.3% in 2016 to 84.5% in 2017 for candidates who passed at least five subjects with C or better. Our best student was Blessing Muningwi who scored 8A\*s, 2As and 1B.
