FORMS ONE AND THREE CONSULTATION DAY

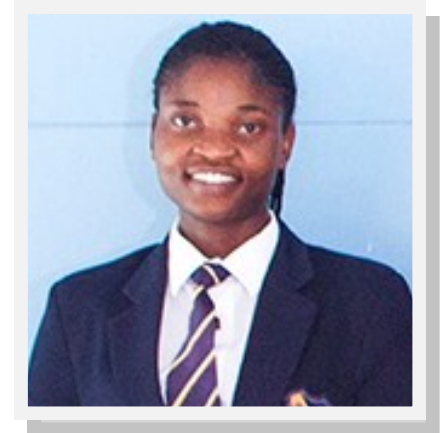
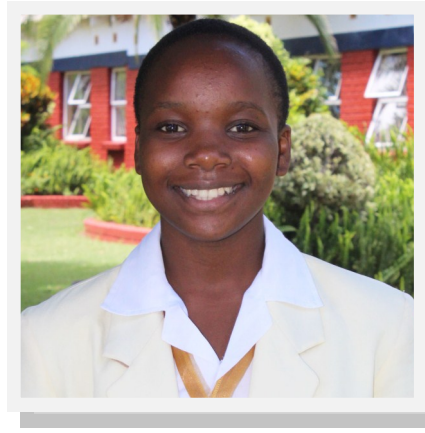
